**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-40**

**TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF WEEKENDER, WORK RELEASE, AND  
PERIODIC IMPRISONMENT SENTENCES AT KANKAKEE COUNTY JAIL**

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Illinois Supreme Court issued an Order M.R. 30370 concerning the ongoing threat of COVID-19 in response to the State of Emergency declared by the Governor of the State of Illinois and the Declaration of a National Emergency by the President of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the Order issued by the Illinois Supreme Court authorizes the Illinois courts to establish and periodically update temporary procedures to minimize the impact of COVID-19.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all weekender, work release and periodic imprisonment sentences at Kankakee County Jail facilities are suspended thru December 31, 2020.

Any defendant ordered to serve weekends, a work release sentence or a periodic imprisonment sentence shall report back to the Jerome Combs Detention Center to continue the sentence on the next regularly scheduled admission date on or after January 1, 2021. Failure to do so may result in an arrest warrant being issued.
